Aims



The TGB Workplace Experience team engaged the services of Blackmores to support in identifying "bottlenecks, barriers to efficiency, lack of engagement" in relation to health & safety management system.

Particularly in relation to risk assessment, permit to work, objectives & wellbeing. The aim was to support the effective launch of the "Keeping you Safe in your Workplace" initiative.

Solution



Completed full risk assessment effectiveness review & managed to reduce the number of assessments by 80% - this resulted in the remaining risk assessment being comprehensive & accessible due to the reduction in number & relevance of content.

- Facilitated structured thinking sessions with Workplace Experience & People functions in how to utilise ISO45003 in assessing wellbeing risks & opportunities - this supported collaborative working between departments in relation to wellbeing topics from both a health & safety as well as a people perspective. (This session also included guidance on new & expectant mother individual risk assessment process.)
- Full refresh of health & safety objectives & associated key performance indicators aligned with risk assessments & opportunities for improvement identified.
- Conducted reviews of a number of new processes to ensure full compliance with the relevant HSE best practice guidance whilst considering efficiency & effectiveness factors based on "real life" experience as a Health & Safety Manager.
- Processes reviewed included electronic permit to work; voluntary events; COSHH controls & assessments; home working including DSE etc.
