During 2022 they made the strategic decision to formalise best practice through implementing an integrated management system compliant to ISO 9001;2015 and ISO 14001:2015. existing sustainability activities and the newly developed values defined by the firm, this has enabled PMC to embed best practice within its core

Engaging with Blackmores, PMC commenced this journey with a kickoff awareness session within the firm to fully understand the internal and external issues, drivers, risks, and opportunities that form the context of both the firm and its management system.

The firm ensured full engagement with the management system through delivery of awareness activities to all and making the management system centrally available on their intranet.

Following a thorough round of internal comprehensive management review, PMC proceeded as planned to formal UKAS certification of their management system with SGS in December 2022, achieved with zero non-conformities.

Next Steps



In recognition of the value they have derived from in-depth internal audits, PMC already invested in a two-day Internal auditor course Blackmores in early 2023 to further strengthen their internal governance team for ISO 9001 and ISO 14001.
